### PORT ALBERT Maritime Museum

The Gippsland Regional Maritime Museum, located in the historic Bank of Victoria building in Tarraville Rd Port Albert provides an excellent opportunity to delve into the colourful past of Port Albert and Gippsland's rich maritime history.

The museum features displays from shipwrecks of the Gippsland coastline as well as the early days of Gippsland Gold discovery as well as many maritime artifacts and boat building tools.

From the moment you step in to the museum you will appreciate the exceptional exhibits on display, ranging from seashells to cannons and maritime navigation equipment from the 18th century to modern day satellite systems.

Opening Hours are 10.30am - 4pm daily Sept - May & Weekends / School Holidays June-August.





This museum is located in Trafalgar, north of the Princes Highway within a quaintly preserved dairy factory. Telling the complete story of the Holden brand, the museum features all things Holden from saddles to motor cars, aero engines to pedal cars.

Among the car exhibits is a 1965 Holden HD Premier with 13,000 miles (21,000km) on it, a 1967 Holden HK also with 13,000 miles and an 1963 EJ Holden with just 7500 miles (12,000km).

"To Preserve Gippsland's Military Heritage" The Museum has achieved Level 1 Accreditation with Museums Australia. It has extensive collection of thousands of items features memorabilia, photographs, stories and displays detailing Gippsland's Military involvement in times of war and peace.

Sit in the pilot's seat of a restored Jet Fighter, climb into a Navy Grumman Tracker aircraft, see how the Australian Light Horseman and his horse were kitted for war and much, much more. The museum is justifiably proud of their collection of model aeroplanes which depicts all the types that have been based in Gippsland by the R.A.A.F.

All major military campaigns involving Gippsland service men and women are featured as well as many display items from Gippsland's three R.A.A.F. WW2 bases and the current East Sale R.A.A.F. base.
